Holiday thieves beware. The Tarrant County DA is coming for you.

(Fort Worth, TX) – Don't be a Grinch this year.

If you steal from others, this office will prosecute your case whether the value of items stolen is big or small.

"Theft will not be tolerated in Tarrant County," said Phil Sorrells, Tarrant County's District Attorney. "We will prosecute thieves who shoplift, steal from parked vehicles, or steal packages from people's porches."

"This is the season of giving, not taking."

Theft increases this time of the year when criminals prey on items that can be stolen from stores, parked cars, or homes – particularly packages left outside.

"This is not Los Angeles, New York, or Chicago," Sorrells said. "We will prosecute all theft cases, no matter the amount."

"We will do everything we can to keep our community safe," he said. "Stop stealing other people's stuff."
