Woman sentenced to life in prison for killing a mother and her daughter

(Fort Worth, TX) – Jillian Johnson pled guilty to killing Gloria Jean Prince, 71, and Gloria Marie Booker, 53, and was sentenced to life in prison.

On October 25, 2020, Johnson was living at the home of Prince and her daughter, Booker, in Grand Prairie. Johnson, 44, was told to move out due to her behavior. Johnson became angry and stabbed both women to death.

Johnson pled guilty last week and was sentenced by the court to life in prison.

Tarrant County Criminal District Attorneys Brittane Hamilton and Terri Moore represented the state.

Wednesday morning, Booker's daughter Tye Jones addressed Johnson in a victim impact statement.

"On October 25, 2020, you shattered my family's life," Jones tearfully told Johnson. "You stabbed two of the most important people in my life."

She said she relies on God to give her the strength to make it through each day without her mother, who was her best friend. Neither her mother nor her grandmother deserved to die the way they did, she said.

DA Investigator Benjamin Lopez and Victim Advocate Laura Flores worked on the case as well.
