Tarrant County Assistant District Attorney Appointed to the 213th Judicial District Court

Fort Worth, TX – Governor Greg Abbott has appointed Assistant District Attorney Michael Ferry to the 213th Judicial District Court in Tarrant County.

Ferry has served in the District Attorney's Office for more than five years, most recently in the Narcotics Unit. In 2024, he also was sworn in as a Special Assistant United States Attorney.

"Michael brings exceptional knowledge, significant experience, and an unwavering commitment to justice – qualities that position him to thrive as a judge and serve the community with distinction," District Attorney Phil Sorrells said. "We will miss him in our office, but I know he will make a lasting difference in the courtroom."

Before joining the DA's Office, Ferry worked as a special agent for the Drug Enforcement Administration. He also served as a lieutenant and surface warfare officer in the United States Navy.

Ferry will succeed former Judge Chris Wolfe, who has been sworn in to serve as District Judge for the Western District of Texas in the Waco Division.

"My heartfelt thanks go to Governor Abbott for giving me this opportunity and to District Attorney Phil Sorrells for standing by me through this journey," Ferry said. "I will work every day to honor this trust and serve with integrity."

Ferry earned a Bachelor of Arts in International Relations from the University of Southern California and a Juris Doctor from the University of San Francisco School of Law.

Ferry's term will expire December 31, 2026.
