SUMMARY

The County Auditor's Office First Assistant retired effective November 30, 2019. We conducted selected procedures to provide accountability over County assets and fiduciary funds in the County Auditor's safekeeping. These procedures included verification of the removal of security authorizations related to fiduciary funds held by the County Auditor. *Exhibit A* further describes the scope of our work. Based on the results of our testing, removal of system access and security authorizations appears to be complete. Since our review was limited in nature, we do not opine on the County's financial statements and internal control structure.

Scope and Methodology First Assistant County Auditor Exit Review November 30, 2019

- 1) Requested the bank to remove the *outgoing* First Assistant County Auditor as a System Administrator for online banking.
- 2) Requested the bank add a new System Administrator for online banking.
- 3) Verified that the *outgoing* First Assistant County Auditor's security authorizations were <u>deactivated</u> for the various County computer systems and applications, as well as the County's online banking.
- 4) Verified the termination of authorization to the Texas County and District Retirement System (TCDRS) website.
- 5) Verified that the *outgoing* First Assistant County Auditor's security authorizations were <u>deactivated</u> for all investments and investment pool accounts.
- 6) Obtained documentation to support the removal and addition of authorized signers for the Accounts Payable signature list and ReadSoft authorizations.
- 7) Documented whether SAP roles assigned to the First Assistant County Auditor should be assigned to other County employees.
- 8) Verified the *outgoing* First Assistant County Auditor surrendered office keys, building/parking access card, and employee identification badge.
- 10) Determined whether the County should be reimbursed for any conference, training fees, dues or memberships paid from the County's general fund for the *outgoing* First Assistant County Auditor.
