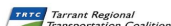

JPS Medical Home Northeast Tarrant

JPS Medical Home Northeast Tarrant, a full service clinic designed to expand access to affordable healthcare, is on track to open in the fall of 2018, with its 32,000-square foot slab foundation now in place at 3200 W. Euless Blvd. Commissioner Gary Fickes stated, "This facility has been a long time coming. We started working with a citizen group six years ago to bring quality, caring healthcare to this area of Precinct 3."

"It's right on schedule," said Angie Morgan, director of construction at JPS Health Network, Tarrant County's publicly supported healthcare provider. "It's so exciting to see it rising from the ground, knowing what an asset it's going to be for our patients and for the communities we serve in Northeast Tarrant County."

JPS broke ground on the new clinic in July. It will replace the JPS Northeast Health Center in Bedford, significantly expanding services that the health network will be able to provide more efficiently. JPS Medical Home Northeast Tarrant will include primary care, women's health, behavioral health, dental, optometry, laboratory, radiology and pharmacy services. "We look forward to it opening within the next year," said Fickes.

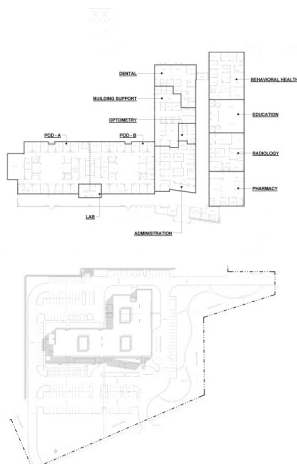

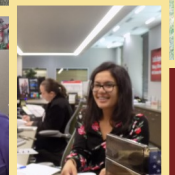
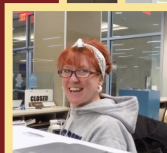
