Dear Legal Professionals:

February 1, 2019 Is Paperless Day!

As previously announced, the District Clerk will no longer print case file documents and/or create a paper file, except for Juvenile, **beginning February 1, 2019.**

Pursuant to TRCP Rule 21(f) (13), the District Clerk has declared the electronic file to be the original case file effective on the above date.

Proper back-up to the electronic records was completed and fully tested last summer. A "hot site" is in place, as part of our redundant back-up system, in case our primary site becomes inoperative.

Please thank Commissioner's Court for making this investment to modernize our computer systems.

Hopefully, the savings on paper, warehouse space, and enhanced security will offset any temporary inconvenience that may occur!

Realizing that there will be a transition period, please do not hesitate to contact us with questions on procedures or other concerns.

Goodbye paper file...Hello electronic file



The District Clerk has worked with several courts in Civil, Criminal and Family in preparation of moving to a more paperless environment. Criminal and Felony/Civil section started 2019 with partial electronic case files on January 2, 2019 with CDC3, 213th, 371st, 396th and the 432nd District Courts pursuant to TRCP Rule 21(f) (13).

Beginning February 1, 2019 all 26 District Courts, except for Juvenile, in Family, Civil, Criminal and Felony/Civil, will be moving to electronic case files only. The District Clerk's office will no longer produce a paper record. Case information will be available electronically through our District Clerk Web Access service and on our public terminals located on the 2nd floor of the Tom Vandergriff Civil Courts Building, the 3rd floor of the Justice Center and the 3rd floor of the Family Law Center.

eFileTexas Redaction Update

On Tuesday, January 22nd at 11:00pm CST, the clerk redaction editing function within eFileTexas was disabled.

Rule 21c of TRCP clearly states that the filer is responsible for redacting sensitive data or marking the document with the appropriate notice in the event that sensitive data is required by law or rule.

Attorney's when preparing a Protective Order and accessing fee to be paid by the respondent please contact the clerk for the total amount of fees incurred.





- No paper files will be provided to attorneys to take to and from court.






Service Request Form


