**A RESOLUTION ISSUING AN ORDER TO CANCEL THE  
GENERAL ELECTION OF CITY COUNCILMEMBERS  
PLACES 3, 4, 5, AND 6 SCHEDULED TO BE HELD  
SATURDAY, MAY 2, 2026, AND DECLARING EACH  
UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Haltom City, Texas (“City”) is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City approved Resolution No. R2026-001-01, calling for a General Election to be held on Saturday, May 2, 2026, as provided by City Charter for City Councilmember Places 3, 4, 5, and 6; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.052 of the Texas Election Code provides that the governing body of a political subdivision by order or ordinance, may cancel the election and declare each unopposed candidate elected to the office upon receipt of a certification from the City Secretary that each candidate is unopposed, no candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidates, and no proposition is scheduled to appear on the ballot; and

**WHEREAS**, Olliephine Anderson, Jeffery Scott Lindgren, Troy Keith Dunn, and Dana Paulett Coffman are the only candidates who filed an application for a place on the ballot by the deadlines prescribed by the Texas Election Code, for Councilmember Place 3, Councilmember Place 4, Councilmember Place 5, and Councilmember Place 6, respectively, for said election; and

**WHEREAS**, the above-mentioned certification has been submitted to the City Council by the City Secretary; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council determines it is necessary to cancel the May 2, 2026, General Election as permitted by Section 2.052 of the Texas Election Code.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HALTOM CITY, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct findings of the City Council of the City of Haltom City, Texas, and are fully incorporated into the body of this Resolution.

**SECTION 2.** Pursuant to the above-mentioned recitals, the General Election scheduled to be held on Saturday, May 2, 2026, is hereby cancelled.

**SECTION 3.** The City Secretary is hereby authorized and instructed to take the necessary actions

to cancel all activities and appointments made through Resolution No. R2026-001-01, and to post a copy of this Resolution at the Haltom City Senior Center and Haltom City Library on the day the election was scheduled to be held as required by Section 2.053 of the Texas Election Code.

**SECTION 4.** Olliephine Anderson, "Ollie Anderson," is hereby declared duly elected Councilmember Place 3, respectively, subject to the oath, and the filing of a bond, as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.







**WHEREAS**, the City of Haltom City, Texas (“City”) is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and






