

REQUEST TO CANCEL FEDERAL POST CARD APPLICATION FOR MAIL IN BALLOT

According to the Texas Election Code and pursuant to the Help America Vote Act, members of the military and U.S. citizens residing outside the United States who request a ballot by mail qualify to receive a ballot at the address listed on their Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) for a period of one calendar year, expiring December 31. Voters who submitted an FPCA, but have returned to Tarrant County and no longer wish to receive a ballot by mail should complete this request to cancel the FPCA.

Please Note: This form cannot be processed within 45 days prior to an election. If this form is submitted within 45 days of an election, it will be processed after the election. If a ballot has already been mailed, voters are permitted to vote in the election after cancelling the current application on file with Tarrant County Elections.
