


Safety guidelines for voting in person



Practice social distancing

While you wait for your turn, make sure you are 6 ft. apart from the person in front of you. The polling place floor will be marked with tape to help the flow of voters, while still allowing enough space between y'all.



Wear a mask or face cover

It is not a requirement, and we will not enforce it, but it certainly makes everyone feel more comfortable if your allergies kick in. Just remember, the Election Judge still needs to see your face when you show your ID.



Scrub in and out

There will be hand sanitizer at the check in table, please use some before handing your ID to the poll worker. After you scan your ballot, you'll find more sanitizer, please use some on the way out (but not before you insert your ballot, wet paper is not good for the scanner!)
