IMPORTANT NOTICE

Effective Monday, July 1, 2019, Justice Court Precinct One will implement MANDATORY E-Filing of ALL cases. Paper case filings will no longer be accepted after July 1, 2019.

On May 16, 2019, the Court officially designated all Court documents as the official Court record. Since November 2018, over 6 months ago, multiple notices have been posted throughout the 1895 Old Courthouse, 100 W. Weatherford St. and in Justice Court Precinct One, Room 450. Also, a notice was posted on the Court's website as to the July 1st implementation.

All Pro Se litigants (parties not represented by an attorney) and attorneys will be required to submit new Eviction, Small Claims, Debt Claims, any subsequent case filings and any other response pleadings via E-File Texas Self-Help or E-File Texas. Any litigant not having online computer capabilities will have access to the computer kiosk in the Justice Court office. Any cases not accepted by E-File Texas Self-Help or E-File Texas will have to be submitted in person.
