IMPORTANT NOTICE

Effective Monday, August 1, 2021, Justice Court Precinct One will implement MANDATORY Electronic Communications for ALL cases. All communications between the Court and litigants MUST be sent to the Court via E-File Texas (Preferred), Email, or Fax and MUST include a valid Email address.

All Pro Se litigants (parties not represented by an attorney) and attorneys are <u>required</u> to communicate with the Court electronically. Electronic communication must be conducted by E-File Texas (Preferred), Email, or Fax. ALL litigant communications MUST now include a valid Email address.

All communications from litigants to the Court and the Court to litigants will be conducted electronically using one of the above means of communication. Be aware; all notices, copies, judgments, and other documents sent by the Court to litigants will come from the JP1court@tarrantcounty.com Email address.

To prevent Court communication from being placed on their Junk folder, litigants are encouraged to add the above Email address listed to their address book under contacts. Litigants are responsible for immediately notifying the Court of any change to their Email address on file with the Court.
