You have the right to plead not guilty, to hire your own lawyer, to confront and cross-examine the State's witnesses, to have the prosecutor prove his case against you beyond a reasonable doubt, to testify or to remain silent, to call your own witnesses, to have a jury determine whether you are guilty or not guilty and, if found guilty, to have the jury or judge assess punishment. Any plea of guilty or no contest must be freely and voluntarily entered. You have 10 straight days from the date of a guilty or no contest plea to file a Motion for New Trial which will be granted.
