

# Termination of Parental Rights Research Guide

## Overview

This guide provides an overview of statutes and resources related to the Termination of Parental Rights, also referred to as “relinquishment” when the process is voluntary. Termination of parental rights is the legal process where the court ends the parent-child relationship between a child and one or both of the child’s parents. Related topics: Paternity and Adoption.
