



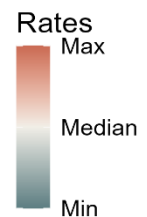

Explanation: Starting January 2025 the report format has changed. Case counts along with case rates per 100,000 people are shown in parentheses. Minimum, Median and, Max are now determined based on the case rate relative to the other years rather than the case count to account for changes in the county's population size. Rates are only calculated when 20 or more cases have been reported year to date.

Less than five reports (1-4) are suppressed. Data are provisional and subject to change.
