Reference: A barricaded subject in western Tarrant County

On June 23, 2025, at approximately 7:45 a.m., Tarrant County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the 11000 block of Dixon Drive on a domestic disturbance call. Upon arrival, deputies located a woman who stated her husband was intoxicated and had been violent towards her in the early morning hours. The woman reported their child was still inside the home with her husband who was refusing to come outside.

Deputies set up a perimeter while negotiators began trying to resolve the situation peacefully. After approximately 40 minutes, a small team was able to enter the home and rescue the child unharmed. The subject remained inside the home and continued to refuse commands to exit. Approximately five hours after the standoff began, the subject surrendered without further incident. He is facing a charge of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon. No one was injured.

The Fort Worth Police Department also responded to the scene to assist in the peaceful surrender of the subject.
