The Tarrant County Sheriff's Office is proud to announce that the Texas Commission on Jail Standards (TCJS) has completed its annual inspection of the Tarrant County Jail and issued a full passing grade. Inspectors issued no technical assistance and no deficiencies were noted. Thus, reaffirming the jail's continued compliance with all state requirements.

The TCJS inspection is a comprehensive review that evaluates all aspects of jail operations, including inmate care, facility conditions, life safety measures, medical services, record keeping, and compliance with state law.
