Tarrant County, TX – Beginning in May of 2025, the Tarrant County Sheriff's Office will launch a groundbreaking human performance initiative designed to support officer wellbeing and optimize readiness. The program, sponsored by <u>The Faith Fight Finish Foundation</u>, will provide a full-time Human Performance Specialist embedded within the department and comprehensive mental health resources - including a series of specialized resilience seminars tailored for law enforcement officers.

The program will be delivered by O2X Human Performance, a Massachusetts-based training and education company founded by former Navy SEALs. O2X works with thousands of first responders nationwide and has designed programs for federal, state, and local agencies across the country. Their evidence-based approach focuses on helping tactical athletes maintain peak performance throughout their careers while addressing the unique mental health challenges faced by law enforcement and other tactical populations.
