INSTRUCTIONS

Submit the completed application, payment in the form of personal check, money order or cashier's check, and any required attachments to your local County Tax Assessor-Collector's office. Do not mail cash. When the specialty plate is issued, additional fees may be collected to establish a single expiration date for both the specialty plate and the vehicle registration. Most specialty plates may be personalized for an additional personalization fee of \$40, make your selection on page 2. **State law requires that you remain unmarried to qualify for these specialty plates.**

"Surviving Spouse Disabled Veteran": The spouse of a deceased Disabled Veteran may apply for this specialty plate if proof is submitted that Disabled Veteran License Plates were issued to the veteran prior to death. A \$3 specialty plate fee is required for the first set of plates. Additional sets of these plates are free, however, the annual registration fee must be paid.

Military Service: The surviving spouse of a military veteran may continue to register one vehicle with the specialty license plate if the specialty plate was issued to the veteran prior to death. The annual registration fee must be paid.

Military Recognition: The surviving spouse of a military veteran may continue to register one vehicle with a Former POW, Pearl Harbor Survivor, or Purple Heart plate, if the specialty plate was issued to the veteran prior to death.

If you ordered by mail, please contact your County Tax Assessor-Collector's office in 2 - 3 weeks to verify your plates are ready for issuance. Contact your County Tax Assessor-Collector if you have any questions.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Texas title and vehicle registration must be in your name.
- If you recently filed an application for title, attach a copy of the title application (VTR-500 RTS) receipt.
- If the vehicle is leased, attach a photocopy of the lease agreement.
- · Vehicle is for personal use only.

SPOUSE ELIGIBILITY

- "Surviving Spouse Disabled Veteran" plate You must be unmarried and sign statement to that effect to obtain this specialty plate. You must also show proof that your spouse was previously issued a "Disabled Veteran" license plate.
- Any Military Service or Military Recognition plate You must be unmarried and sign a statement to that effect to retain the license plate. You must also show proof that your spouse was previously issued the military plate indicated.
- Proof of current liability insurance.

PERSONALIZE YOUR PLATE - If you would like to personalize your specialty plate, there will be an annual \$40 fee, in addition to any other required registration or plate fees. The following plates may not be personalized: Former POW, Texas National Guard, and Armed Forces Reserve.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Show selections exactly as you want them to appear on your license plates. You may list more than one selection in the event the personalization you have chosen is already issued.
- A selection that has already been issued, is deemed offensive, or conflicts with the regular license plate numbering system cannot be approved.
- Use each selection block below to represent one character defined as one letter, number, period, dash, blank space, Texas silhouette, or the heart symbol. Use an asterisk (*) to indicate the Texas silhouette, and an at sign (@) to indicate the heart symbol.
- Passenger car and truck plates are limited to six (6) characters total, except for the Pearl Harbor Survivor and U.S. Paratrooper plate which is limited to five (5) characters total.
- Motorcycle/moped plates are limited to four (4) characters total.
- You are not required to use all the spaces provided.
- The International Symbol of Access counts as two (2) characters. If you are disabled and applying for personalized specialty plates, the plate may consist of three or four characters.

Personalization fee will not be refunded once application is submitted.
